

Another Baker Family Tree

In 2023 I was contacted by , as it turned out, a third cousin, once removed¹, Anthea Baker, concerning her Family Tree studies. She comes from a branch of my Lichfield ancestors as outlined in the [Parental Grandfather Family Tree](#). Specifically the common ancestor are James Baker (1821 -1860) and his wife Ann Lees (1814-1858). My line follows through their son Thomas (1846-1907) and Anthea's through a younger brother, Joseph Alfred (1854-1933). In my research I had, to my shame, failed to find Joseph at all. I used Anthea's research to update and correct some of the details of the earlier generations in my Paternal Grandfather line. In this document, with her permission, I include further detail of her research. Firstly I give her family trees in diagrammatic form as follows.

- Baker Tree 1 (page 2) is the main section of Anthea's tree, before and after James and Ann. The earlier generations parallel those in the documents elsewhere on this site.
- Baker Tree 2 (page 3) shows an extension of Tree 1 to give fuller details of the siblings of those in the main line of descent.
- Baker Tree 3 (page 4) shows an extension of Tree 1 to connect with the more recent generations in my tree.
- Walton Trees 1 and 2 (pages 5 and 6) show the quite complex interactions between our common Lichfield Walton ancestors .

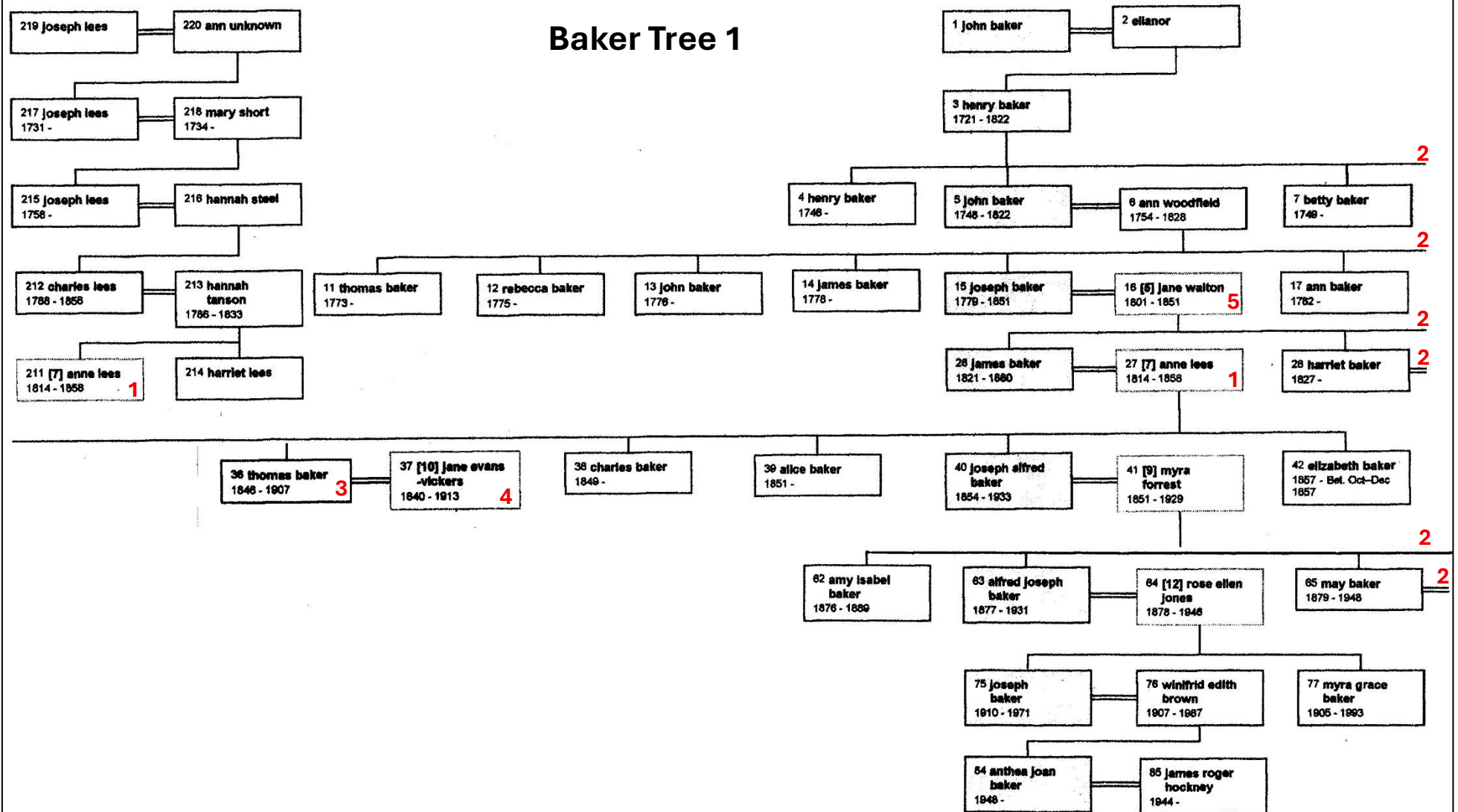
The connections between the various components of the trees are given by red numerals, and the links should self explanatory. It will be obvious from these trees that Anthea includes much greater detail of the siblings of the main characters of our joint trees than I have in my research. After the trees, I then give Anthea's record sheets for the main characters in her tree and our joint tree, in chronological order by birth date with the earliest first (pages 7 onwards).

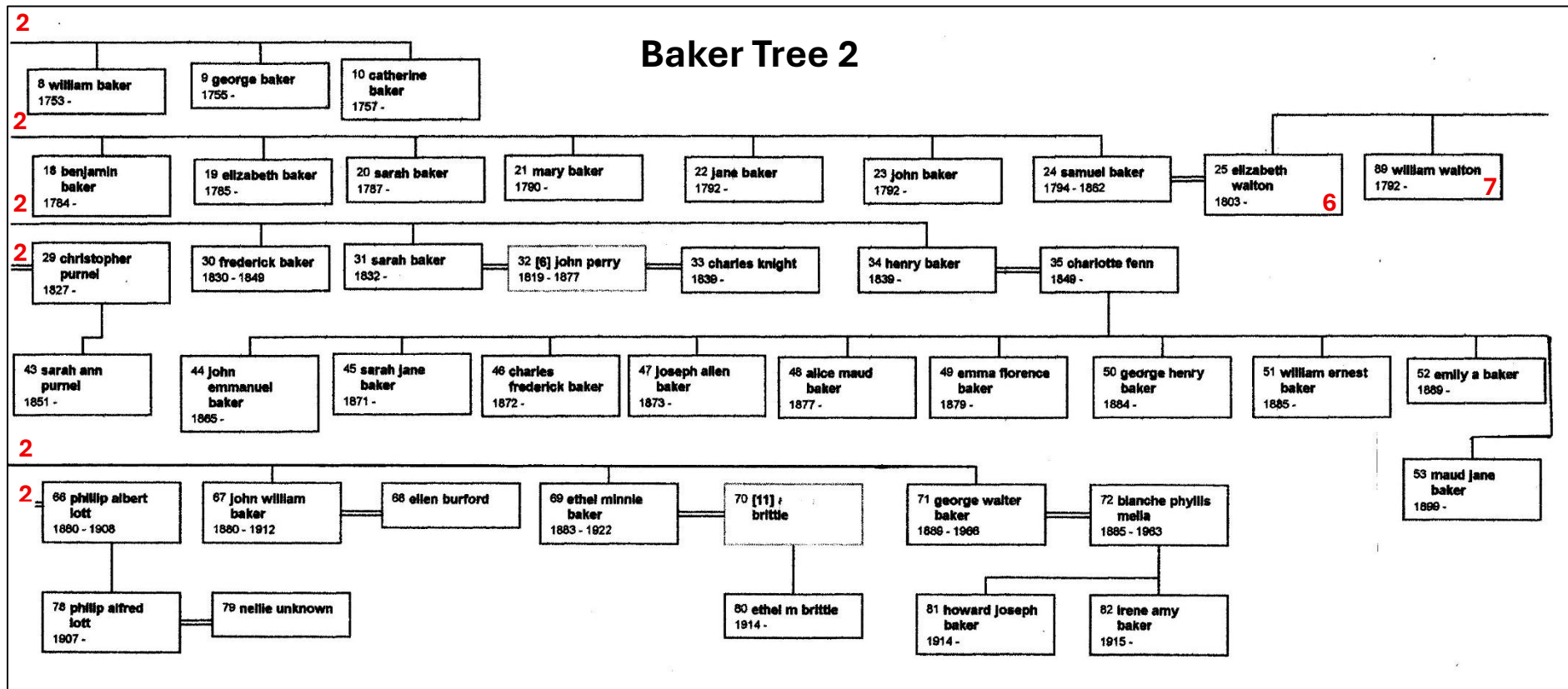


Joseph Alfred Baker 1854-1933

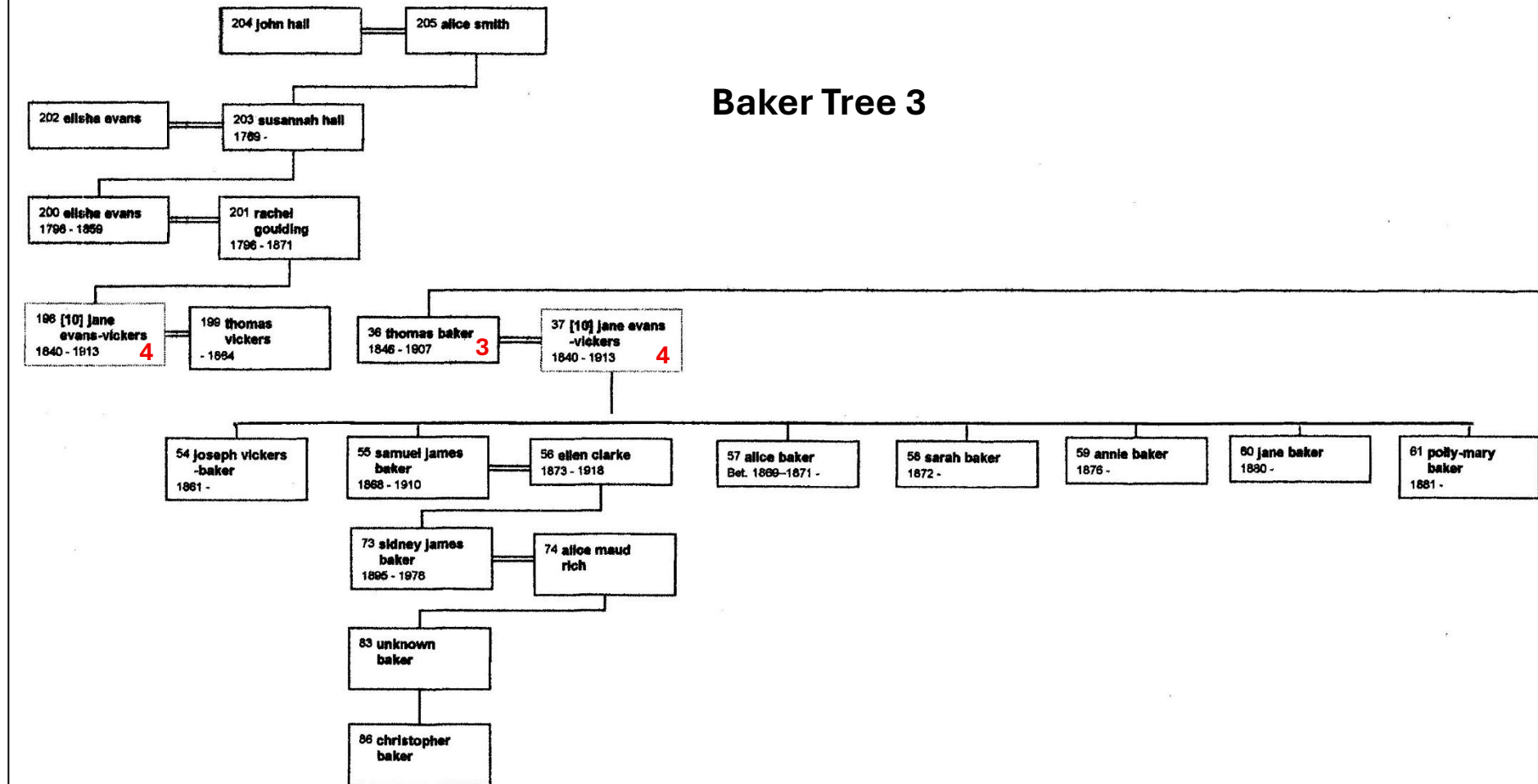

Baker Tree 1

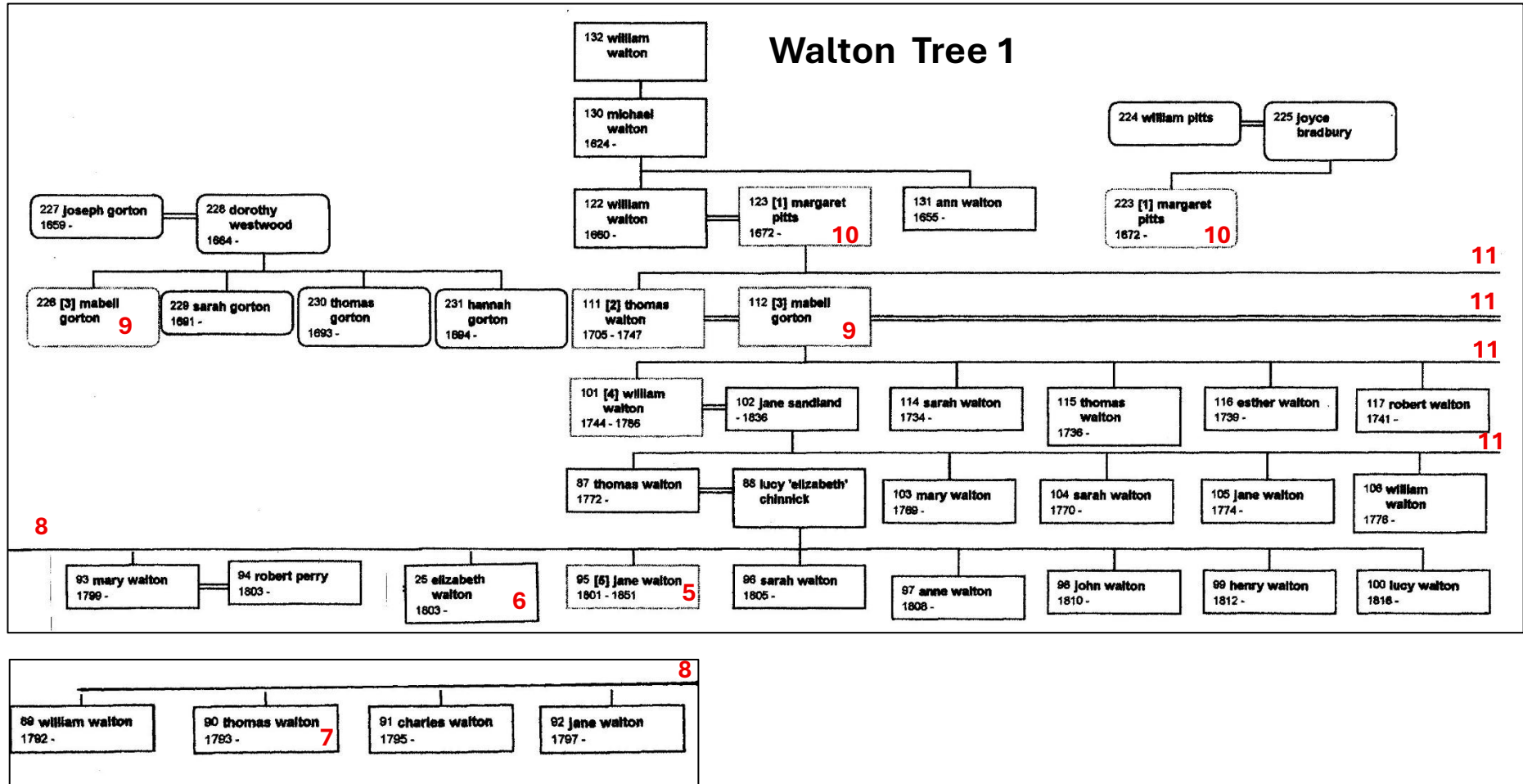


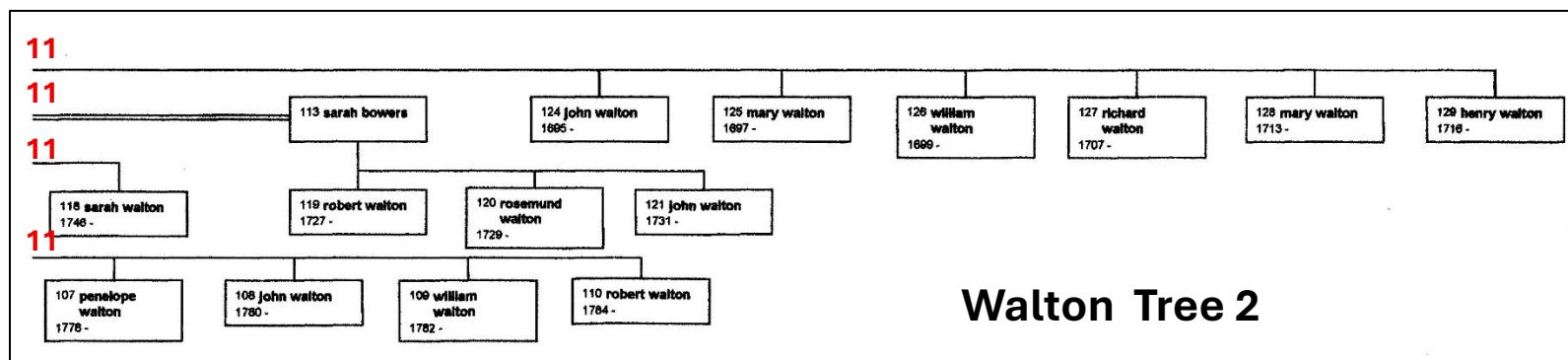


Baker Tree 3
